ESSENTIALS: SKETCHBOOK

A new sketchbook is magical!
The beginning of a new story.

I personally like sketchbooks with fine grain watercolor paper.

They are resistant, don't let colors go through the pages and are easy to draw on, with fine line pens.

A 5 Sketchebook light,
watercolor paper 120 lb / 250 gsm



PAINTBRUSHES

I use a regular watercolor brush but also one with a water container attached. It is very useful since you don't need a cup or water with you.

When using a normal brush I carry with me the foldable cup. Not a must but I admit I love it. Small and light to carry with me.
